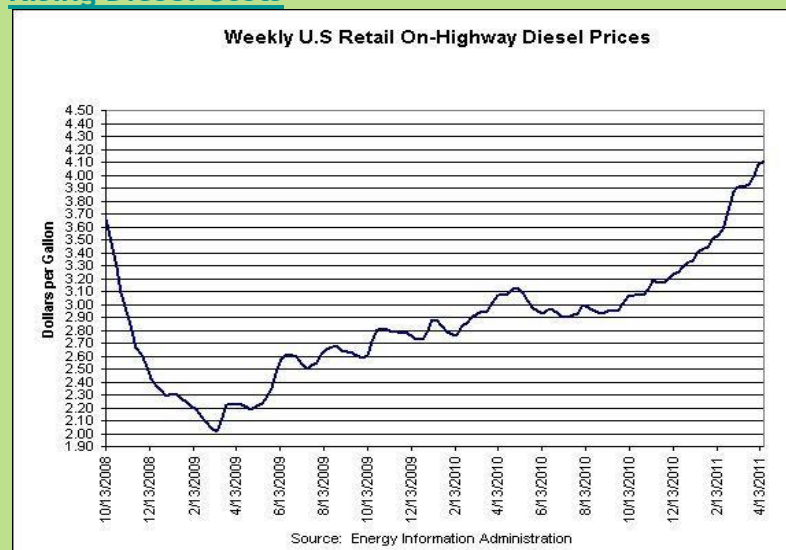
Kim Gerner

Beat until well blended.
